

Scholarships and Donations Policy

Last revised: September 2024

1.0 VCCFA Cheryl Draper Scholarship

1.1 The VCCFA (FA) will give two scholarships each year.

1.1.1 An applicant must be the child or spouse of a VCCFA member in good standing.

1.1.2 The applicant must be planning to attend a Canadian public post-secondary institution, usually for the year in the application was submitted.

1.1.3 The detailed procedures for application shall be as outlined on the Scholarship Application form. Applications can be obtained from the VCCFA Union office.

1.2 The VCCFA Executive will appoint a subcommittee, under the direction of the Vice President, to recommend the successful applicant for the Executive's consideration.

1.2.1 The names of all applicants and other identifying information such as phone number and address will be removed from the applications and each assigned a number to help the sub-committee members with their recommendation.

1.2.2 Late applications will not be considered.

1.2.3 Letters of support, reference or recommendation are not needed and will not be read.

1.2.4 Unless there are no other qualified applicants, an applicant may only receive one full scholarship within any four-year cycle.

1.2.5 All applicants will be informed of the decision of the sub-committee.

2.0 VCC Student Awards

2.1 The VCCFA will support student awards through the VCC Foundation for a minimum annual amount of \$6000.

2.2 Criteria will be established in consultation with the Foundation.

3.0 Requests for Donations

3.1 Requests for funds from the Donations budget line will be considered by the Executive on a case-by-case basis.
